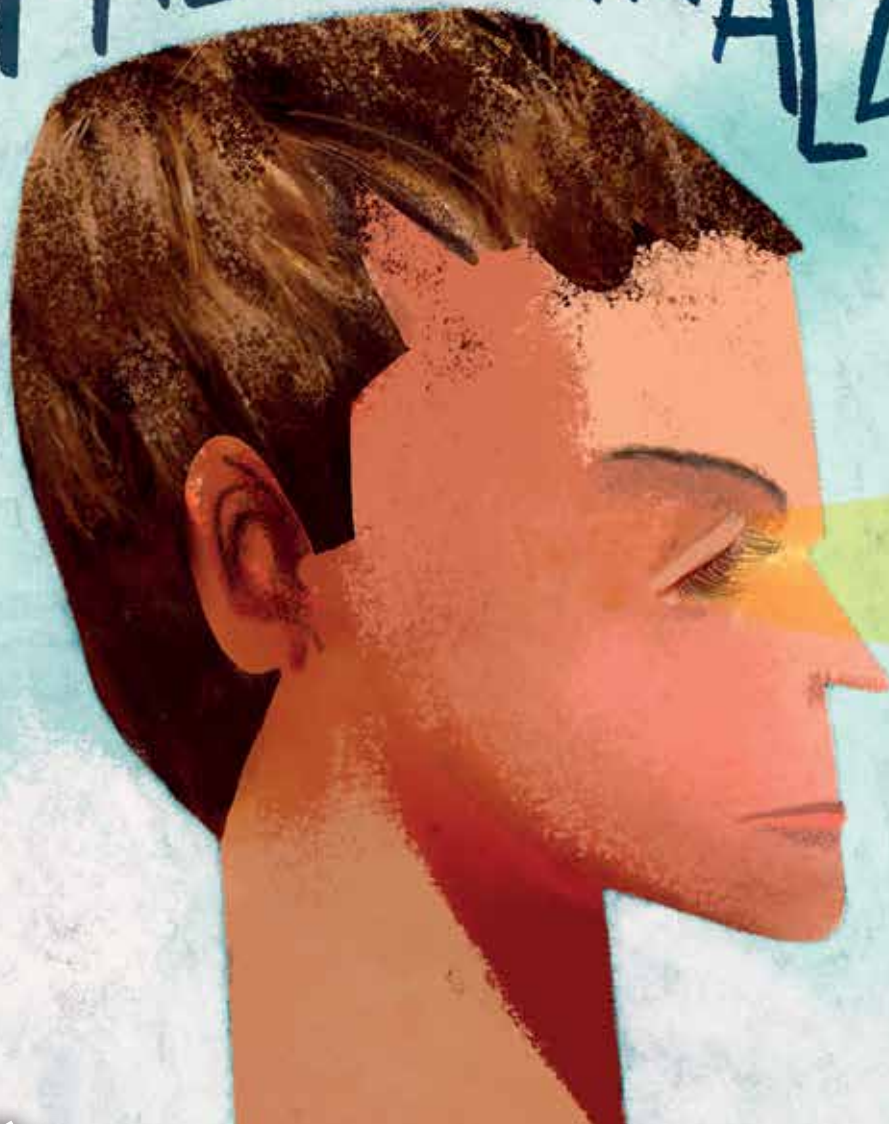

Presented to the best factual film.

AUDIENCE AWARDS

These will be awarded at the heats and senior finals and are decided by an audience vote.
To be eligible someone must be at the screening to represent your film.

- Completed after 22 January, 2016.
- 15 mins or less (Senior), 10 mins or less (Junior). These times are inclusive of title and end credits.
